

Going for a COVID Vaccine at the Chancellors Hotel





You will go to a building called the Chancellors Hotel to have the COVID vaccination.

Chancellor's Hotel is in the Manchester University Sport's Ground off Moseley Road, Fallowfield

How to get there?



There is a car park, including disabled parking outside the vaccination centre, so you can come by car or taxi



Or you can get on the bus to take you to the Chancellors Hotel. You can get buses 142, 143 or 147



You will get off the bus at the Friendship Inn bus stop on Wilmslow Road



Carry on walking down the road
until you see Carill Drive.

Turn right onto Carill Drive.



Turn Right onto Moseley Road &
walk to the first set of traffic
lights



Turn left at traffic lights & you will see
a friendly marshal in a yellow jacket
who will guide you from there.



A marshal will show you the way to
the entrance



Please wait at the front doors when you arrive. A marshal will be there to say hello and to show you where to go.



Use the hand sanitizer to clean your hands.



When you are in the building, keep your mask on all the time if you can. Let us know if you are worried about wearing a mask



The stickers or black and yellow tape on the floor will tell you where to stand. Keep 2 metres away from other people.



There will be a person at a table. They will ask you what your name is and your date of birth.



You may be asked to sit in the waiting area

Our friendly marshalls will know when you are next and will show you where to go.



You can use the toilet if you need to.

What happens next?



You will be welcomed by the staff team who will take you to the 'pods' for your vaccination.



When you go inside the pod you will be asked to sit down on the chair. Your carer can stay with you.



The pharmacists are here to look after the vaccines



The vaccinator will ask if it is OK to give you the vaccine.



The vaccine will go into your arm. It will be over quickly. When you are having the vaccine, talking about what you are having for dinner can sometimes help.



There are quiet rooms you can go to at any point if you want to have a quiet space, or to feel more relaxed.



A doctor will be available to speak to you if you feel unwell or if you are worried

What happens after your vaccination?



After having the vaccine, you can leave the pod. You might be asked to wait for 15 minutes in another room. This is to make sure you feel OK.



Sometimes you don't have to wait, and you can leave straight away. The marshals will tell you when you can leave.



Your arm might be sore after your vaccination.

You might feel tired and you might have a headache.

This will not last for any more than 2 days. There will be people there to help if you don't understand.





You have now had your vaccination.
You can now go home. The NHS will be
in touch about having the second
vaccine.
